\$140 per credit hour: CE In-state tuition rate applies for *all* Students
Native Tuition Waiver applies for qualified Students

➤ **Fixed Costs: \$1,930**

Includes: Tuition for 7 credits, instructor's expenses, program and entry fees, fieldtrips, and contingencies; paid to *Fort Lewis College* at the Cashier's window in Berndt Hall

\$750 non-refundable deposit – pay to FLC Cashier immediately upon application

\$1,180 final program costs due March 31, 2010 – pay to FLC cashier's office

➤ **Out-of-Pocket Costs: \$1,525 (Estimated)**

Includes: Room and Board, Books, Airfare, and Entertainment

★ **TOTAL Estimated Expense: \$3,455** ★

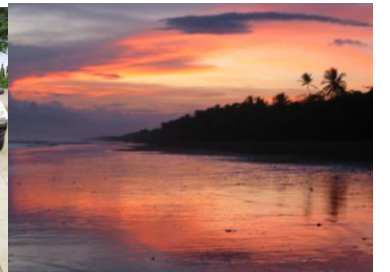
