

## Archeology Technician

Colorado National Monument is looking to hire a current student to fill a seasonal STEP appointment as a GS102 Archeology Technician, at the GS-09 level, during the 2009 field season. The position would extent for up to 7 payperiods, with the duration and timing of the appointment flexible based on college schedules. As a GS-09, candidates would need 2 full years of progressively higher level graduate education or master's or equivalent graduate degree, or 1 year equivalent of specialized experience at a GS-07 level or higher. Duties will involve a mix of field and office work including locating and documenting archeological sites, entering information into an established data base, and completing associated paperwork.

Colorado National Monument is located 7 miles from Fruita and 17 miles from downtown Grand Junction, Colorado. Grand Junction area has a population of approximately 100,000. Housing and all other services are available in the community. Housing costs are considered high; the rental market is currently limited. Elevation at park headquarters is approximately 5800 feet with weather conditions typical of western mountain plateau country. Most community facilities are located in Grand Junction, including Mesa State College, hospitals, shopping facilities and churches. Biking, hiking, climbing and other outdoor sports are primary attractions of the area.
