Forest-wide Flammulated Owl surveys
Owl nest box monitoring

Skills needed:

Driver's license & ability to drive a stick shift
Basic GPS, map reading, and compass skills
Basic bird identification skills
Ability to camp during the week
Willingness to work in woods after dark during owl surveys
General fitness and ability to navigate across rough terrain
