IME BECAS Scholarship 2023 Application

The IME Becas Scholarship is a partnership between the Institute for Mexicans Abroad (IME) and Fort Lewis College, to provide financial assistance to students with Mexican origins. The \$1,000-\$2,000 scholarship is intended to help remove financial barriers for students seeking to complete their bachelor's degree at Fort Lewis College; it can be used towards the cost of tuition, books, fees, or housing expenses. The Selection Committee will select recipients based on eligibility, financial need, educational achievement, and essay completion.

Incomplete and/or late applications WILL NOT be considered.

All materials must be turned in by Tuesday, September 26th at 5:00 pm to Gyana B. Gomar at: gbgomar@fortlewis.edu or in person at: El Centro de Muchos Colores (Student Union 40).

Eligibility:

- 1. Must be Mexican or have parents of Mexican origin (will need to provide documentation)
- 2. Demonstrate significant financial need
- 3. Be enrolled as a full-time degree-seeking student at FLC
- 4. Have at least a cumulative 2.75 GPA

Preference will be given to:

- 1. First-generation students
- 2. Students who demonstrate a commitment to supporting the immigrant community

To apply:

- 1. Complete and sign the application form (page 3)
- 2. Write two essays (250-500 words each)
 - Essay #1: Tell us about yourself and why you think you are deserving of this scholarship.
 - You can share information about your family background, ways you have supported the immigrant community (if applicable), involvement on campus, leadership roles you have taken on, ways you or your family continue to keep cultural traditions alive, or anything else you feel would be important for the committee to know about you.
 - Essay #2: Describe how this scholarship would support you in reaching your academic and professional goals.
 - Please make sure you mention how these funds will be utilized if you receive the IME Becas Scholarship and share with us what your long-term professional goals are.

- 3. Submit supporting documents:
 - A copy of one (1) of the following documents: Mexican birth certificate, Mexican birth certificate of one parent, Mexican passport, Mexican passport of a parent, consular ID card, IFE or INE.
 - Copy of your most recent transcript. If you're a first-year student, submit your last high school transcript. If second-year or above, submit a copy of your latest college transcript.
