

Key to Terms: WebCAPP Degree Evaluation

Program	Degree Requirements: the courses required for a student's declared majors, minor (if any), and General Education requirements from the declared catalog term.
Catalog Term	The catalog term specified when a student petitions to graduate, typically the first term he or she attended Fort Lewis College.
Evaluation Term	The term when the evaluation was completed. This will default to a future term by WebCAPP. Leaving it on the default term does not make a difference in the evaluation results.
Met, "Yes or No"	Whether or not that area of requirements has been completed.
Required	The number of credits needed to complete a degree requirement.
Used	The number of credits that have been applied to a specific degree requirement (or courses—see column labeled "used" in the 2nd section starting with "Total Required").
Institutional Required...Out of Last Earned	The number of credits a student must complete at Fort Lewis College, i.e., a student must complete 30 of their last 40 credits at FLC under the current catalog (note: older catalogs required 28).
Program GPA	The GPA of all courses used to satisfy requirements stated on the Degree Evaluation report (this may or may not match the cumulative GPA.) This GPA is not used by Fort Lewis College.
Overall GPA	The cumulative GPA of all courses taken (excluding certain transfer courses). This matches the cumulative GPA stated on a student's transcript and must be a minimum of a 2.00 by the date of graduation.
Transfer	The number of transfer credits (or courses, see last column again) used to meet specific requirements.
Unused	The number of credits (or courses) that were not used to meet any specific requirement. These credits count toward the total credits required for a degree at FLC (120 or 128 depending on catalog year) .
Area	Each section of the degree program, i.e., Upper Division, General Education, Major Core, Major Auxiliary, Minor, etc.
Term	The semester in which you took the course (or in which your transfer occurred). The number you see is a code: the first 4 numbers represent the school year, i.e. 2007 means 2007-08. The last 2 numbers represent the term: 02 is Fall, 03 is Winter, 04 is 1 st summer session, 05 is 2 nd summer session, 06 is 3 rd summer session. So 200702 means the course was completed in the Fall of 2007; 200703, would be the winter of 2008.
Attribute	The code which describes what a course counts for, i.e. a course with a "B" attribute counts toward the General Education Group B, Natural Sciences requirement; a course with the "TS2N" attribute counts toward the Thematic Studies, Natural Environment requirement.
Source	"H" means the course was taken at Fort Lewis College; "T" means the course is from another college and was transferred into FLC either before or after the student matriculated.
