AND
 2. U.S. Citizen
AND
 3. Working towards 1st Bachelor's Degree
AND
 4. Neither one of your supporting parents (or legal guardian) had a Bachelor's Degree before you were 18 years old*
 - OR** You applied for financial aid and received a Pell Grant
 - OR** You have a documented disability.
- * preference given to students who qualify in more than one criterion
