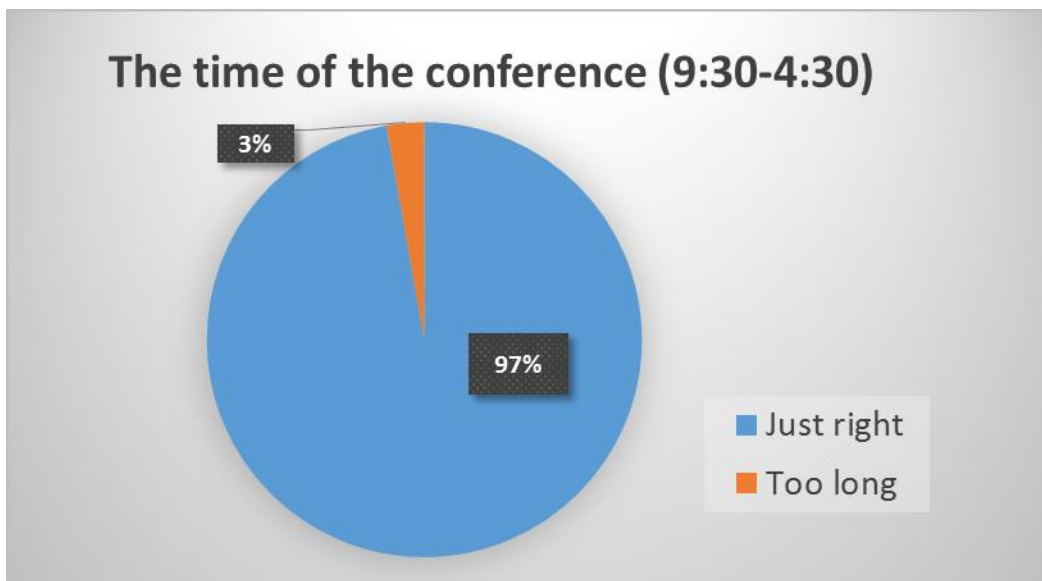


## Feedback from Participants
